The Bach dynasty spans seven generations of musicians. The most famous among them, **Johann Sebastian**, is so significant that he overshadows the rest of the family. Yet, in his time, his reputation was mainly as a virtuoso organist: among his sons, **Wilhelm Friedmann** and **Johann Christian** were far more recognized as composers than he was, not to mention the major influence of **Carl Philipp Emanuel** (1714-1788) on the entire 19th century.

Each of Bach's sons exhibits very unique qualities and gradually moves away from their father's mastery of counterpoint, which marks the end of the Baroque era...


